Starting this fall the program will have new requirements that incorporate our new Great Conversations courses.

NEW REQUIREMENTS

Great Conversations (6 hrs)

• Take at least two GCON courses designated as an Honors section.

Honors Colloquium (4 hrs)

Complete four distinct HONR101 courses.

Advanced Honors Experience (6 hrs)

 Elect at least 6 credits of advanced coursework from HONR301, HONR390, Professional Internships, or Study Abroad.
